Top 5 Initiatives for Undergraduate Students:

- Academic support services (including tutoring, supplemental instruction, and educational planning) that teach the skills needed to be a successful student (88%)
- Expanded career-related opportunities (87%)
- On-campus job opportunities (86%)
- Access to scholarships and financial aid information (84%)
- Career-based experiential learning and internship opportunities (83%)

Top 5 Initiatives for Graduate Students:

- Funding for graduate student academic travel, presentations, and professional development (88%)
- Expanded career-related opportunities (80%)
- Access to scholarships and financial aid information (78%)
- Academic support services (including tutoring, supplemental instruction, and educational planning) that teach the skills needed to be a successful student (78%)
- On-campus job opportunities (76%)
